**Bottom line:** NEVER use a bulb with more than .1% UV-B (that is, 1/10 of 1 percent), without explicit recommendation and careful medical supervision from your veterinarian. Even in that case, we suggest that you get a second opinion. UV-B can injure your bird's eye and cause cancer.
